Covid-19 Island Use Safety Protocols
Effective May 18, 2020

- Per state and local county advisories, those persons most at risk are advised not to go; members who are at risk and do not feel comfortable around others, should probably not go to the island when other members are present. If you are sick or have a fever-Stay Home!
- Members planning on boating to the island are requested to email out an advisory of their intent to go to the island. Indicate arrival and departure dates and times. This requirement is to provide information to all members in their decision making for going to the island.
- The docking of boats is to be done in a manner that provides a minimum separation of 6 feet to other docked boats and if boats are docked on both sides they should be staggered and to also maintain a 6 foot separation.
- If any member boat intends to deploy a dingy, kayak or other water craft they must provide a greater boat separation from adjacent boats to maintain a minimum 6 feet separation.
- Wear masks when off your boat and in proximity to other persons or boats on the dock.
- Do not touch or volunteer to assist arriving or departing boats or dock lines unless asked by the boat operator. Boat operators not requesting docking assistance should be capable to safely dock or depart without causing injury or damage to the dock or other boats.
- No shared community food, including drinks or appetizers. Persons should only handle food containers related to their particular boat. If food is consumed on the island it shall not be shared.
- If the BBQ is being used, masks shall be worn and social distancing shall be observed.
- Guests of members shall be required to fully comply with these safety protocols.
- Members at the island by themselves should be prepared to fully comply with each above listed safety measure should other member boats arrive.
